IN THE EVENT NONE ARE AVAILABLE, THEN A NOTARIZED STATEMENT OF RESIDENCY FORM "AFFIDAVIT OF LANDLORD" (which may be obtained at the Longwood Central Registration Office), <u>MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF TRANSPORTATION EITHER ONLINE (longwood.k12.ny.us) OR IN PERSON AT CENTRAL REGISTRATION.</u>

An application is late if it is filed after April 1, 2022 or if filed more than 30 days after establishing residence in the Longwood Central School District. In this event, the application must be completed by the parent/guardian providing a "reasonable explanation for the delay" as required by Chapter 719 of the Education Law as amended.
